If any such third-party requestors desire for use of the Material in any product(s) offered for sale or process(es) for the manufacture thereof or as a part of commercial service, such request(s) will be forwarded to Depositor.
- 5. CDC shall acknowledge the Depositor as the source of the MATERIAL in any publications made by CDC reporting use of it, unless requested otherwise.
- 6. Any Material delivered pursuant to this Agreement is understood to be experimental in nature and may have hazardous properties. THE DEPOSITOR MAKES NO REPRESENTATIONS AND EXTENDS NO WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED. THERE ARE NO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES
