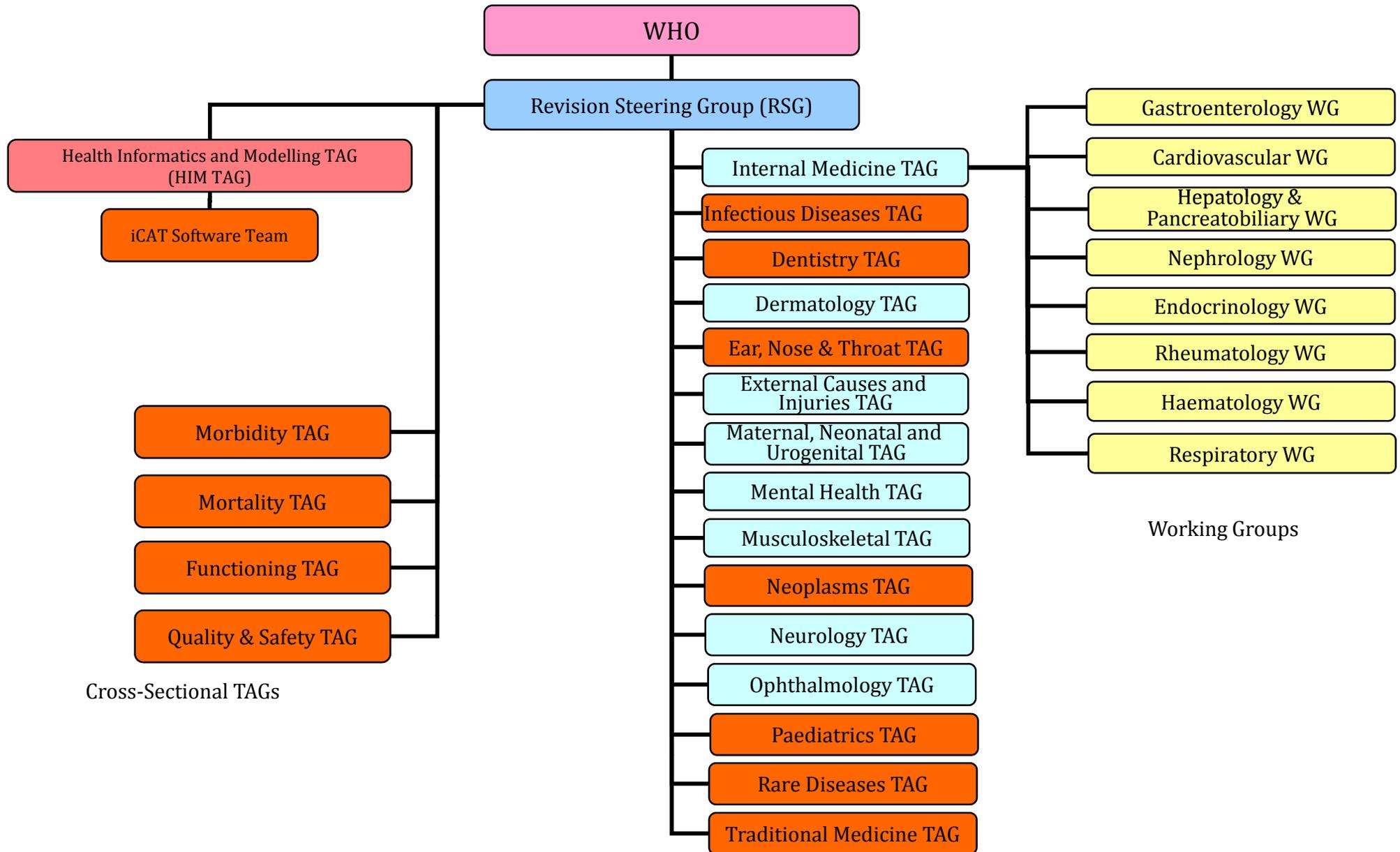

Horizontal TAGs

Mortality TAG

- **Mortality Coding Rules** → ICD11 integration
- **Verbal Autopsy** use case & Other use cases

Morbidity TAG

- **Morbidity Coding Rules:** Discharge summary; Casemix – DRG
- **Specialty adaptations-** extension principles
- **National Adaptations** Links

Functioning TAG

- Contribution to **Functional Properties**
- **Shared “Entities”** between ICD and ICF
 - Category Level: Blindness – Deafness – Mental Retardation etc.
 - Symptoms – Body Impairments
 - Contextual Factors – **Chapter Z**

Quality and Safety TAG

- Quality **Indicators**
- Safety **Indicators**
- **Shared “Entities”**
 - Injury chapter- “iatrogenic “
 - ICPS links
