Objectives of the Workgroup

- Advise on DHCS/OAE specific issues, DVS specific issues, & common issues (e.g. mortality coding)
 - Advise on how to maximize what is currently done to benefit endusers.
 - Advise on how to maximize products developed and their dissemination.
 - Identify how we should move forward.
 - Answer or advise on experts who can answer questions specific to the task(s).
- Specific workgroup functions will evolve over the life of the projects

Examples of Questions

- Are there limitations and advantages of various medical coding systems in capturing opioid-involved ED visits?
- Are there any existing natural language processing methods used to identify conditions in EHR clinical techniques that could be applied to these projects?
- What advice can be given for the coding/classification of drugs for the end-product data file?
- What should we consider when redesigning the current Mortality Medical Data System (MMDS) to incorporate specific drug information captured in the literal text on the death certificates?
- What information about opioid related deaths is most important for realtime surveillance?
- Are there new lists of current drug names and nomenclature that can be used to identify drugs in death certificate and EHR clinical notes data?
