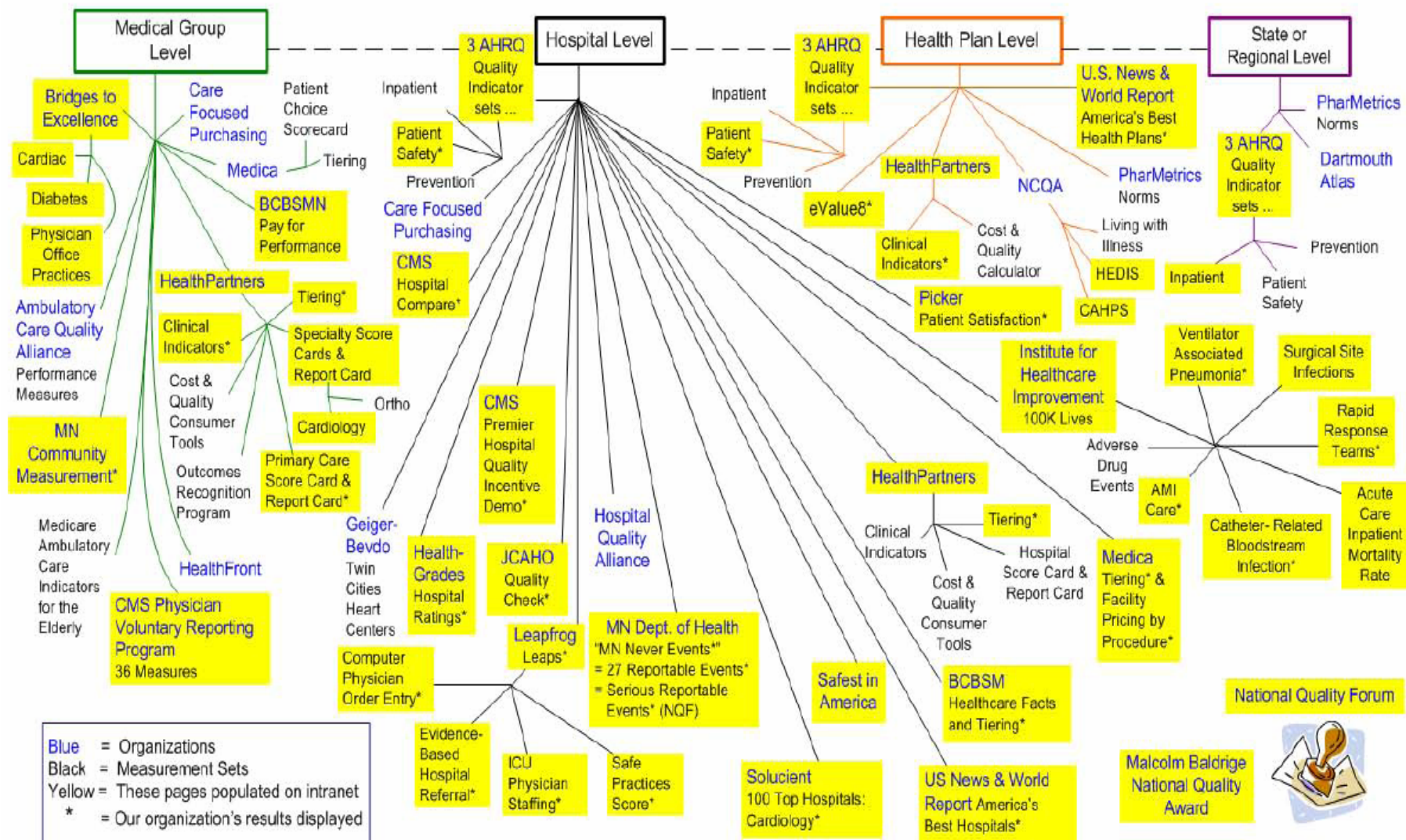
Scope of reporting for one health system

“Measures Map” of Standard Measurement Sets

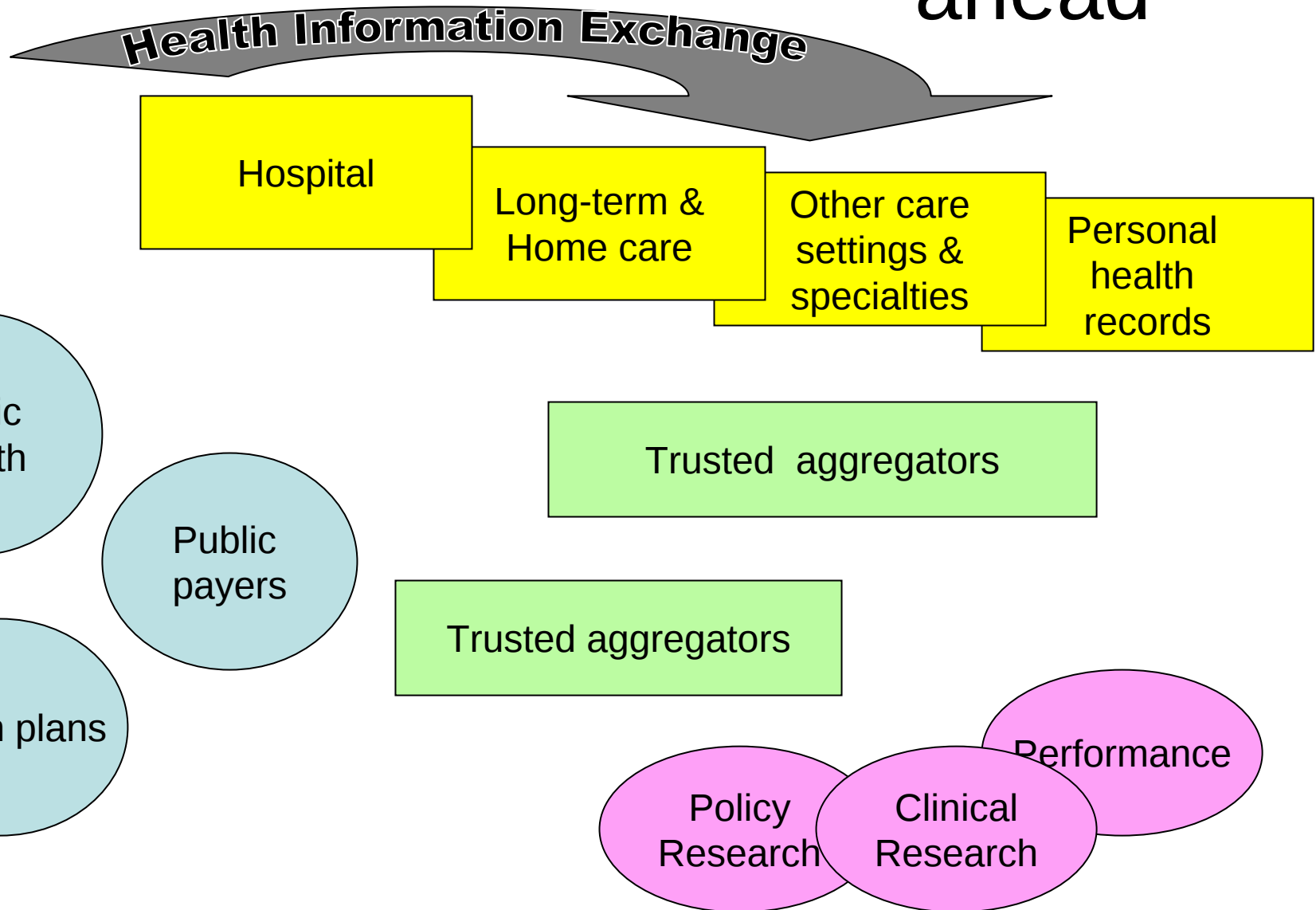

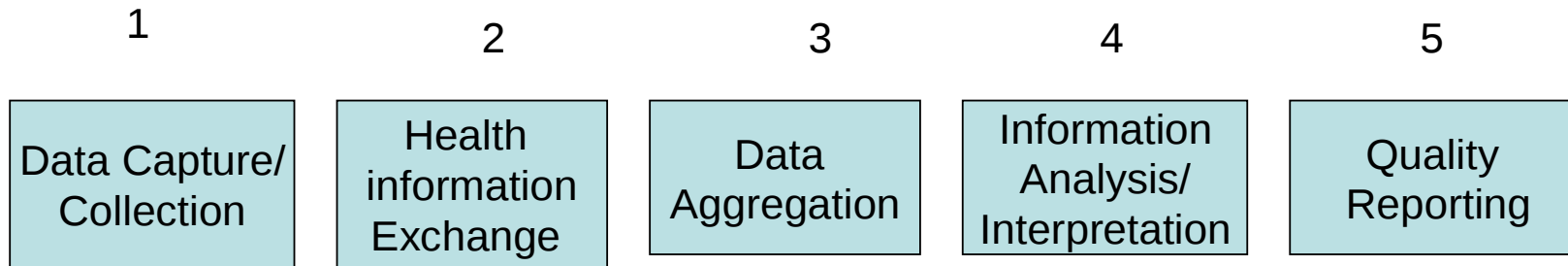
