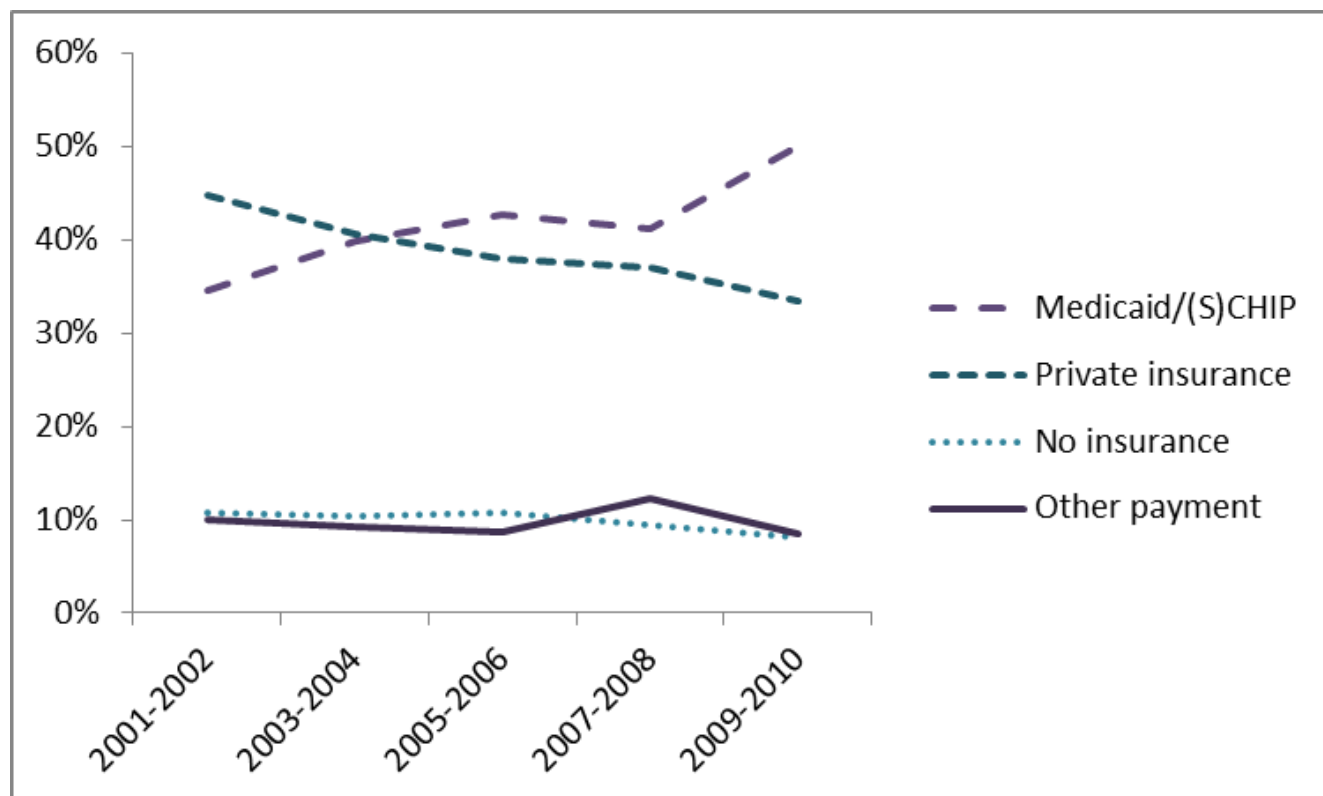

Percentage of Emergency Department Visits by Persons Aged ≤ 18 Years, by Primary Expected Source of Payment —United States, 2001–2002 to 2009–2010

- During 2009–2010, Medicaid or CHIP was the primary expected payment source for 50% of visits to an emergency department by persons aged ≤ 18 years, up from 34% during 2001–2002.
- During the same period, the percentage of visits with private insurance as the primary payment source decreased from 45% to 34%, and the percentage of visits with no insurance payment decreased from 11% to 8%.
