The NHCS will provide nationally representative data on utilization of hospital care and healthcare statistics on inpatient, emergency, and outpatient care. This will be a valuable resource for monitoring healthcare delivered in the United States. This new data collection will address healthcare policies related to the cost of care, inpatient quality and safety, disparities, and access. Your participation in this survey, although voluntary, will ensure the successful launch of a new, more comprehensive tool for monitoring the future of healthcare.

NCHS has a long history of protecting the confidentiality of patient records and the facilities that participate in its surveys. All information collected will be the property of the NCHS and kept strictly confidential. Results from the national survey will be published only in an aggregated manner that will not allow identification of any individual hospital or patient.

Your full participation is needed to ensure that future National Hospital Care Survey data will be useful to hospitals and to the entire health care community.
