## About the 2020 State Estimate Web Tables Supplement to NCHS Data Brief No. 453

The Long-Term Care Statistics Branch is pleased to release adult day services center (ADSC) participants-specific stat estimate web tables, using data from the fifth wave of the National Post-acute and Long-term Care Study (NPALS) conducted in 2020 by the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS).

These adult day services center-specific state web tables complement Data Brief 453. Table 1 provides state estimates of the characteristics presented in Data Brief 453 and Table 2 provides the standard errors for those estimates.

Estimates are presented as percentages. Data are presented in the state web tables only if they meet NCHS' confidentiality and reliability standards. Footnotes are included in the state web tables to indicate if estimates do not meet NCHS' confidentiality or reliability standards. The data sources and methodology used to develop the state web tables are the same as those used for Data Brief 453. For more information on the data source and methodology, please see the "Data source and methods" section in Data Brief 453.

## **About NSLTCP**

NPALS provides reliable, accurate, relevant, and timely statistical information to support and inform long-term care services policy, research, and practice. The main goals of NPALS are to: (1) estimate the supply, provision, and use of paid, regulated long-term care services in seven major sectors; (2) estimate key policy-relevant characteristics of providers and service users, and provider practices; (3) produce national and state-level estimates, where feasible; (4) compare estimates among sectors; and (5) monitor trends over time. NPALS comprises two components: (1) survey data collected by NCHS on assisted living and similar residential care communities and residents, and on ADSCs and participants; and (2) administrative data on nursing homes and residents, home health agencies and patients, hospices and patients, inpatient rehabilitation facilities and patients, and long-term care hospitals and patients obtained from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). The restricted 2020 survey data files for the residential care community and ADSC sectors are available through the NCHS' Research Data Center (https://www.cdc.gov/rdc/index.htm).

The ADSC survey was conducted between November 2020 and July 2021. NPALS uses a multi-mode survey protocol with mail, web, and computer-assisted telephone follow-up for nonresponse. The questionnaires included survey items on provider characteristics such as ownership, size, services offered, selected practices, and staffing in addition to aggregate service-user characteristics, such as age, sex, race, and the number of participants needing assistance with activities of daily living.

Survey data were collected by RTI International under contract to NCHS. The 2020 ADSC mail questionnaire and survey documentation are available at: https://www.cdc.gov/nchs/npals/questionnaires.htm.

The ADSC sampling frame was constructed from lists of licensed ADSCs acquired from the licensing agencies in each of the 50 states and the District of Columbia, and included 5,466 adult day services centers, which were all included in the data collection. Of the 4,103 in-scope and presumed in-scope ADSCs, 1,780 ADSCs completed the provider questionnaire, for a weighted response rate (for differential probabilities of selection) of 43.0% (this is calculated by using AAPOR's Response Rate 4).
