Other i	ons of the lower respiratory tract must meet at least <u>one</u> of the following criteria:	
1.	Patient has organism(s) seen on Gram stain of lung tissue or pleural fluid or identified from lung tissue or pleural fluid (when pleural fluid was obtained during thoracentesis or initial placement of chest tube and NOT from an indwelling chest tube) by a culture or non-culture based microbiologic testing method, which is performed for purposes of clinical diagnosis or treatment, for example, not Active Surveillance Culture/Testing (ASC/AST).	
2.	Patient has a lung abscess or other evidence of infection (for example, empyema) on gross anatomic or histopathologic exam.	
3.	Patient has imaging test evidence of abscess or infection (excludes imaging test evidence of pneumonia), which if equivocal is supported by clinical correlation, specifically, physician documentation of antimicrobial treatment for lung infection.
