Reporting Plan	VAE has been removed from the monthly reporting plan for HOSP-PSYCH and CMS-certified IPF Units in the Add Monthly Reporting Plan page. This prevents Inpatient Psychiatric Hospitals (HOSP-PSYCH) and CMS-certified IPF Units from adding VAE reporting plans.
