

## NHSN v13.1.2 Release Notes

Changes to Dialysis Component (DIAL)	
<b>Analysis and Reporting</b>	<p>The following reports were updated with version 13.0.0 Surveys for 2025:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Line Listing – Outpatient Dialysis Center Practices Survey</li> <li>- Line Listing - Home Dialysis Practices Survey</li> </ul>
<b>Dashboard</b>	<p><b>HAI/Dialysis Event Dashboard:</b> A new dashboard was created to display Dialysis Event data submitted by dialysis facilities into NHSN. Data/statistics will be presented such as the count and rate of COVID cases, BSI rate, days since last infection, BSI SIR &amp; CAD, and percentage of patients with CVC, all in graph and/or table form with adjustable timeframes. This is available for both Facility and Group users.</p>
<b>Enrollment</b>	<p>A new facility type, <b>AMB-HEMO-NTDS - Non Traditional Dialysis Setting</b>, has been added to Enrollment for the Dialysis component. This new facility type allows NHSN to track patients being dialyzed in long term care settings by home health agencies.</p>

Changes to Long Term Care Component (LTC)	
<b>Dashboard</b>	<p>A new dashboard, <b>Respiratory Pathogens and Vaccination Dashboard</b>, is available for both Facility and Group users depicting the summary of data submission for Residents for the following pathogens: COVID-19, Influenza, and RSV.</p>

Changes to Patient Safety Component (PS)	
<b>Alerts</b>	<p>For <b>Partial Survey Alerts</b> for the Annual Surveys (HOSP, LTAC, IRF), users no longer have the Save option but a Submit option to successfully add the partial survey.</p>
<b>Analysis and Reporting</b>	<p><b>2022 HAI Rebaseline</b> - The following reports are now available with the 2022 risk adjustment models:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SIR – CAH CAUTI Data (2022 Baseline)</li> <li>• SIR - CAH CDI FacWideIN LabID Data (2022 Baseline)</li> <li>• SIR – CAH CLABSI Data (2022 Baseline)</li> <li>• SIR – LTAC CLABSI Data (2022 Baseline)</li> </ul>
<b>Bed Capacity</b>	<p>Hospitals and smaller jurisdictions that are participating in the Hospital Bed Capacity Project can now ingest data into NHSN using the <b>upload API</b> for Bed Capacity data.</p>
<b>Infectious Diseases of Public Health Concern</b>	<p>There is a new data collection user interface (UI) for the <b>Infectious Diseases of Public Health Concern Form</b>. Facilities can now manually report via the UI the number of patients newly admitted and currently hospitalized with certain diseases in acute care hospitals.</p>
