

AERIAL LIFTS:

Proper Use Prevents Falls

- ✓ Follow the manufacturer's instructions
- ✓ Use proper fall protection
- ✓ Watch out for uneven ground, potholes, bumps, and debris that could cause the lift to tip over



- ✓ Close lift-platform chains or doors, and check guardrails
- ✓ Do not climb on or lean over guardrails
- ✓ Do not exceed the load limits
- ✓ Avoid contact with overhead hazards

During 2011-2017, 2,400 workers were injured and 158 died while operating an aerial lift.
