

MAST CLIMBING WORK PLATFORMS

Best practices for using Mast Climbing Work Platforms (MCWPs or mast climbers):

- ✓ Inspect the equipment according to manufacturer guidelines and recommendations.
- ✓ Conduct ongoing checks for changes to the equipment and the job site.
- ✓ Refer to the rate load chart on equipment to avoid overloading a mast climber.
- ✓ Make sure all workers have been trained by a qualified person.*
- ✓ Select a competent person* to oversee the mast climber.
- ✓ Use a personal fall arrest system when working at heights and near an open edge.
- ✓ Monitor changes in weather.


