Pursuant to our conversation, this letter will introduce MOST Health Services, Inc. for your review and consideration.

Our organization provides comprehensive on-site testing. We have tested over 175,000 union members for asbestos related disease. All medical testing is performed by a certified medical staff on forty-five (45) foot trailers. Electricity, heat, and air-conditioning are self-contained and powered onboard, giving the flexibility of performing testing in any location. Test equipment is identified as follows:

**X-RAY-** The Chest Radiographic Units are hospital grade, "state of the art", 300MA, 120KV, high speed tube systems. To insure no patient motion, rare earth film and intensifying screens are utilized. A grid system insures the ultimate in diagnostic image quality. The most important component is the phototiming system. This system will guarantee 99% of readable film. No film will have to be repeated due to under or over exposure. We have an onboard film processor to check the consistency of technical work.

**PULMONARY FUNCTION-** This system is completely computerized. A printout gives predicted and measured values for all functions.

Our radiologist, Richard Levine, M.D., is a NIOSH "B" reader at The Medical College of Pennsylvania. Michael Goldstein, M.D. interprets our pulmonary function tests. He is a Board-Certified Occupational Medicine Physician and the former Director of the Department of Environmental Protection of N.J.

As you are aware, the concept of mobile testing is to bring diagnostic services to the customer. The mobile system is designed to perform up to one hundred (100) two view chest x-rays and pulmonary function tests within an eight (8) hour day.

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Our testing capabilities are national in scope and service. We have six medical units and our scheduling remains flexible for your needs.

I'm sure you will find that our diagnostic standards are equal to or better than you would find in a hospital or clinic.

Pricing for interpreted studies are as follows:

- Interpreted two view chest x-ray = \$62.00
- Interpreted pulmonary function test = \$22.00
- Interpreted Four view chest x-ray = \$80.00

A minimum number of 50 examinations per day is required.

In addition to the cost per patient, there is a minimal charge for transportation and set-up depending on the distance the medical unit is transported from site to site and shipment charges for product to your office.

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An agreement must be signed and a deposit of 10% of the estimated contract is needed before scheduling.


The following services are available as well:

- Scheduling (watts line) - per patient = 1.50
- Screening Notification (includes postage & labor) per person notified = .55

In addition, because we have conducted so many programs for labor unions throughout the United States, we are constantly being contacted by these and other referred unions to perform screening programs.
