- This Committee is responsible for documents on the requirements for professional qualifications, professional competence, training, procedures, and equipment for emergency responders to hazardous materials/weapons of mass destruction incidents.

- Nashville meeting (09/ 2016) – NFPA 472 and 473 Second Draft Meeting.
- Atlanta meeting (01/2017) – worked on draft NFPA Hazmat Handbook.

## Outputs

- Emergency Responders adequately trained in the use of CBRN rated respiratory protection equipment and associate PPE through the guidance material developed by NIOSH.
