September 15 - 16, 2015

As we approach the meeting date, I want to provide some additional logistical details for all attendees. Documents on the NIOSH NPPTL website.

The technical sessions and lunch will be held at the [Lakeview Resort](#).

Directions available.

Check-in is guaranteed at 3:00 PM on the date of arrival. There are several restaurants in close proximity to Lakeview. List available.
Check out time is 12:00 noon on the day of departure.

Lakeview offers free internet service in all guest rooms, meeting rooms, and public areas.

Registration will begin at 8:00 AM on Tuesday, September 15 outside the meeting room. You will receive your name badge, agenda, and copy of the abstracts. Technical sessions will be held from 9:00 AM until 12:00 noon with a short mid-morning break. Lunch will be served in the same room that the technical sessions are held. The lunch selection will include a vegetarian option. Sessions will resume at 1:00 PM and continue until 3:00 PM with a short mid-afternoon break.

The bus will depart for the Social Event at Heston Farms starting at 5:00 PM. If necessary, it will run two trips (depending on the number of people). After all in our party have arrived, the staff will talk about the process they use for making their wine and whiskey. For those who are interested in wine or whiskey tasting, this will be available for a nominal fee. Dinner will be served at 7:00 PM. The bus will make two trips back to Lakeview, starting at 9:00 PM. If you are not at least 21, you will not be able to partake in the spirits but are welcome to join for dinner and networking. Photo ID will be required. If your spouse is attending with you, the cost for participation will be \$40. Payment can be made via check (payable to ISRP Americas Section) or cash. Judi Coyne will collect at the registration desk in the morning. We will use wristbands to identify members of the ISRP group at the venue.

On Wednesday, September 16, those interested will visit the NIOSH facility. We do not have bus transportation for this outing, so we are counting on carpools to transport those without vehicles. Unfortunately, government regulations do not allow non-government employees to be transported via government owned vehicles. Privately-owned vehicles will leave Lakeview at 8:00 AM. Tours will conclude by 1:00 and as necessary, carpools will return guests to Lakeview to continue their travel. To access the facility, you will need to provide photo identification. If you are a non-U.S. citizen, and completed the paperwork required and have

been approved, you will need to provide the same form of identification at the NIOSH facility for entry (e.g. passport, permanent resident card).
