On behalf of the Oak Ridge Associated Universities (ORAU) Team, I would like to update you on the current status of the claim you filed under the Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act of 2000 (EEOICPA). Your claim was recently reviewed and we have determined that sufficient information has been gathered from the available records sources to initiate reconstruction for your claim.

To avoid the potential for actual or perceived Conflict or Bias (COB) issues in the dose reconstruction effort, ORAU has established a policy of selecting Health Physicist(s) to work on the dose reconstruction for your claim who were not involved in dosimetry or dose reconstruction at the site(s) represented in your claim. Once the dose reconstruction report is completed, you will receive a copy of the report for your review and have an opportunity to participate in a closing interview.
