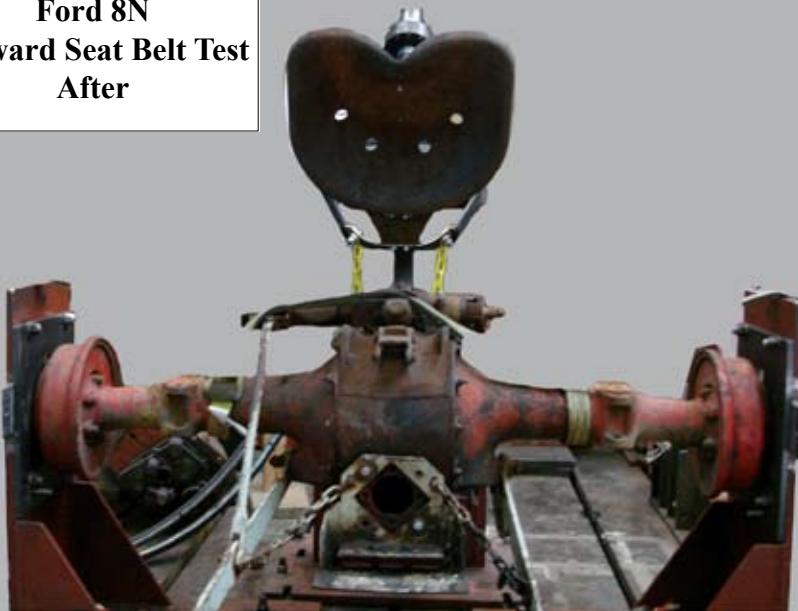

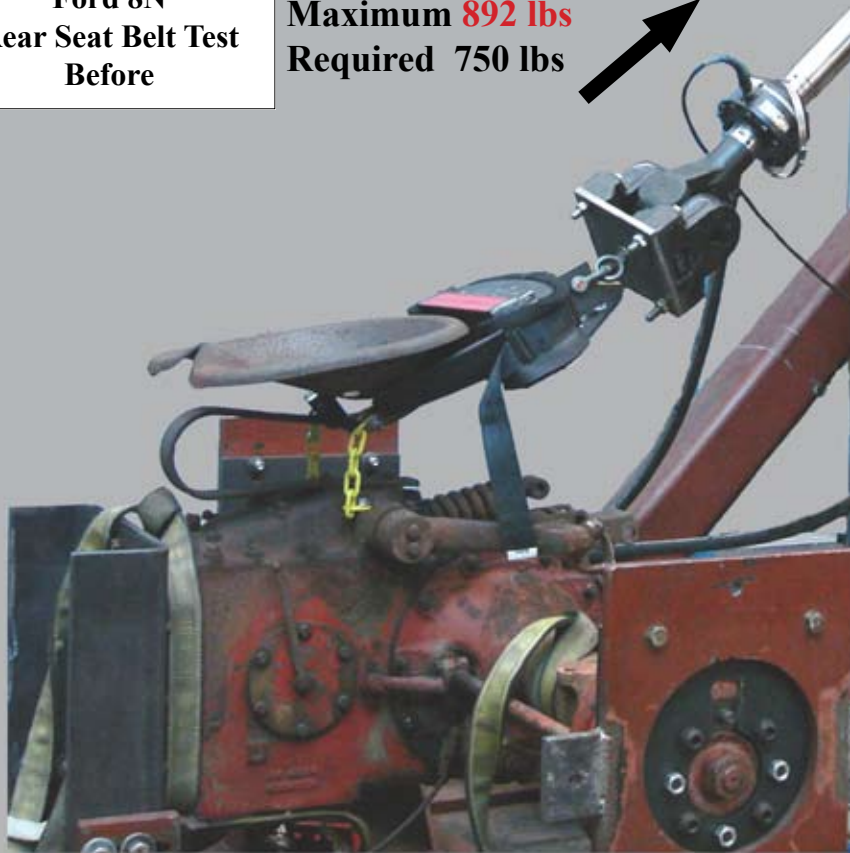


**Ford 8N

Before**

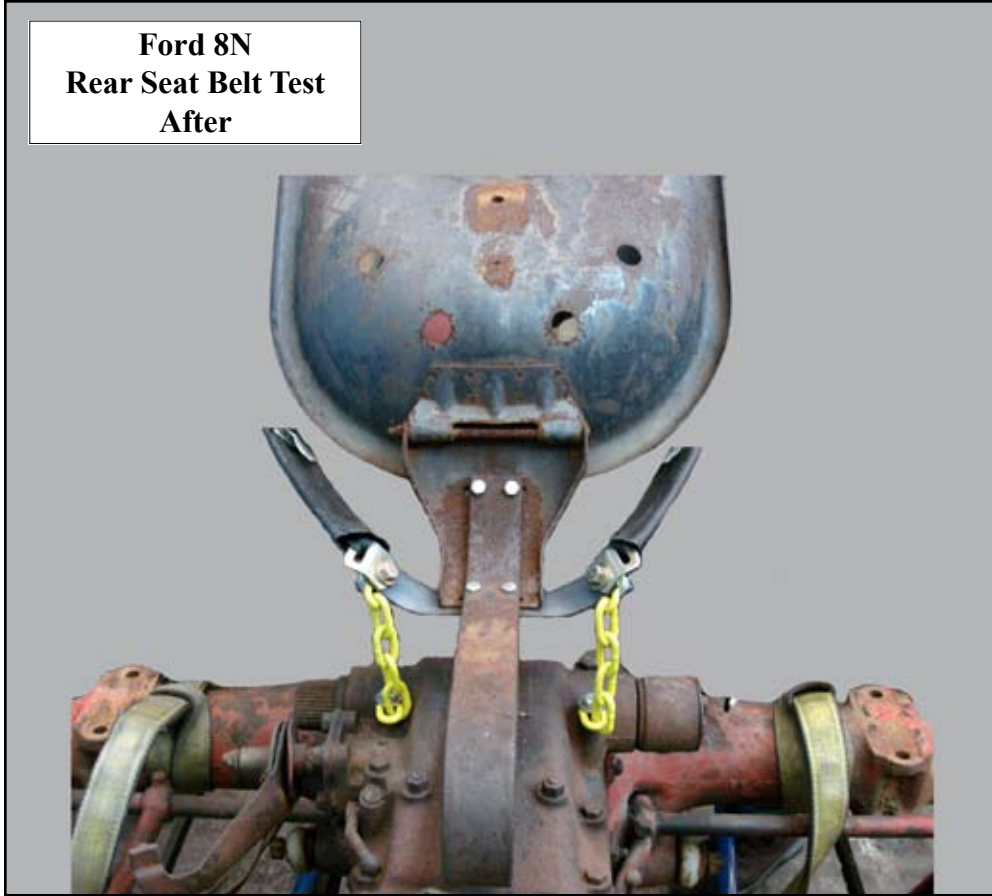
