Notifiable Conditions Topic Area Now Available on CDC WONDER:

CDC WONDER has added a "Nationally Notifiable Conditions" topic area on its web site to make data on notifiable infectious diseases, noninfectious conditions, and disease outbreaks easily accessible in one online location. Available at <http://wonder.cdc.gov/WelcomeT.html#NNDSS>, the new topic area was developed in collaboration with the CDC notifiable noninfectious conditions programs and as a follow-up to discussions between CDC and CSTE in 2015 on making notifiable conditions data more accessible to the jurisdictions and the public online.

Providing this access at a single web site is also consistent with the work CDC has done to respond to a 2013 request from CSTE that CDC include notifiable noninfectious conditions and disease outbreaks data in the [Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report publication](#) of the annual summary of notifiable infectious diseases.

MESSAGE MAPPING GUIDE DEVELOPMENT UPDATES

Priority MMGs Update: Final versions of the Generic v2,

Hepatitis, and Arboviral v1.3 Message Mapping Guides (MMGs) and their associated artifacts have been posted to the NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource Center at <https://wwwn.cdc.gov/nndss/case-notification/>.

Pilot test-ready versions of the STD, Congenital Syphilis, Mumps, and Pertussis MMGs also are available on the resource center.

Varicella MMG Update: The 30-day external comment period for the draft Varicella MMG closed on 6/8/16. CDC received several comments from jurisdictions and is preparing responses to these questions.

New MMGs Identified for Development in 2016: CDC posted draft MMGs for Malaria and Babesiosis to the NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource Center at <https://wwwn.cdc.gov/nndss/case-notification/> for 30-day external reviews; the review period for Malaria is 6/7/16 to 7/20/16, and the review period for Babesiosis is 6/15/16 to 7/27/16. CDC expects to post the draft Measles MMG to the NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource Center in late June for a 30-day external review. In addition, CDC is preparing proposed data element lists for Rubella, Congenital Rubella Syndrome, Cyclosporiasis, and Trichinellosis, which will form the basis of future draft MMGs.

MESSAGE VALIDATION, PROCESSING, AND PROVISIONING SYSTEM UPDATES

MVPS Prepares for Initial Release of Generic v2 and Hepatitis: CDC is incorporating final improvements to the Message Validation, Processing, and Provisioning System (MVPS) to prepare for the expected onboarding of jurisdictions for Generic v2 and Hepatitis case notification messages later this summer. MVPS is undergoing extensive internal testing to ensure that the system is of the highest quality.



Jurisdictions Encouraged to Check SAMS Access: In anticipation of MVPS being ready to accept data from jurisdictions for Generic v2 and Hepatitis later this summer, the NMI team is encouraging all non-pilot jurisdictions to check whether they have CDC Secure Access Management Services (SAMS) access and, if not, take the steps necessary to obtain it. METS Expected To Be Available in July: CDC expects that the Message Evaluation and Testing Service (METS) will be available for jurisdictions to use to validate their case notification messages in July. CDC will provide guidance materials about METS, when launched, to help jurisdictions use the tool.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE UPDATES

June NMI eSHARE Focused on Jurisdictions' Experience in Preparing for HL7 Case Notification Implementation:

On 6/16/16, CDC hosted an eSHARE webinar with a roundtable of four public health jurisdictions who discussed their experience in preparing for HL7 case notification implementation. It presented solutions that may work for other jurisdictions and that encourage collaboration and sharing:

- collaborating on new data collection pages: panelists

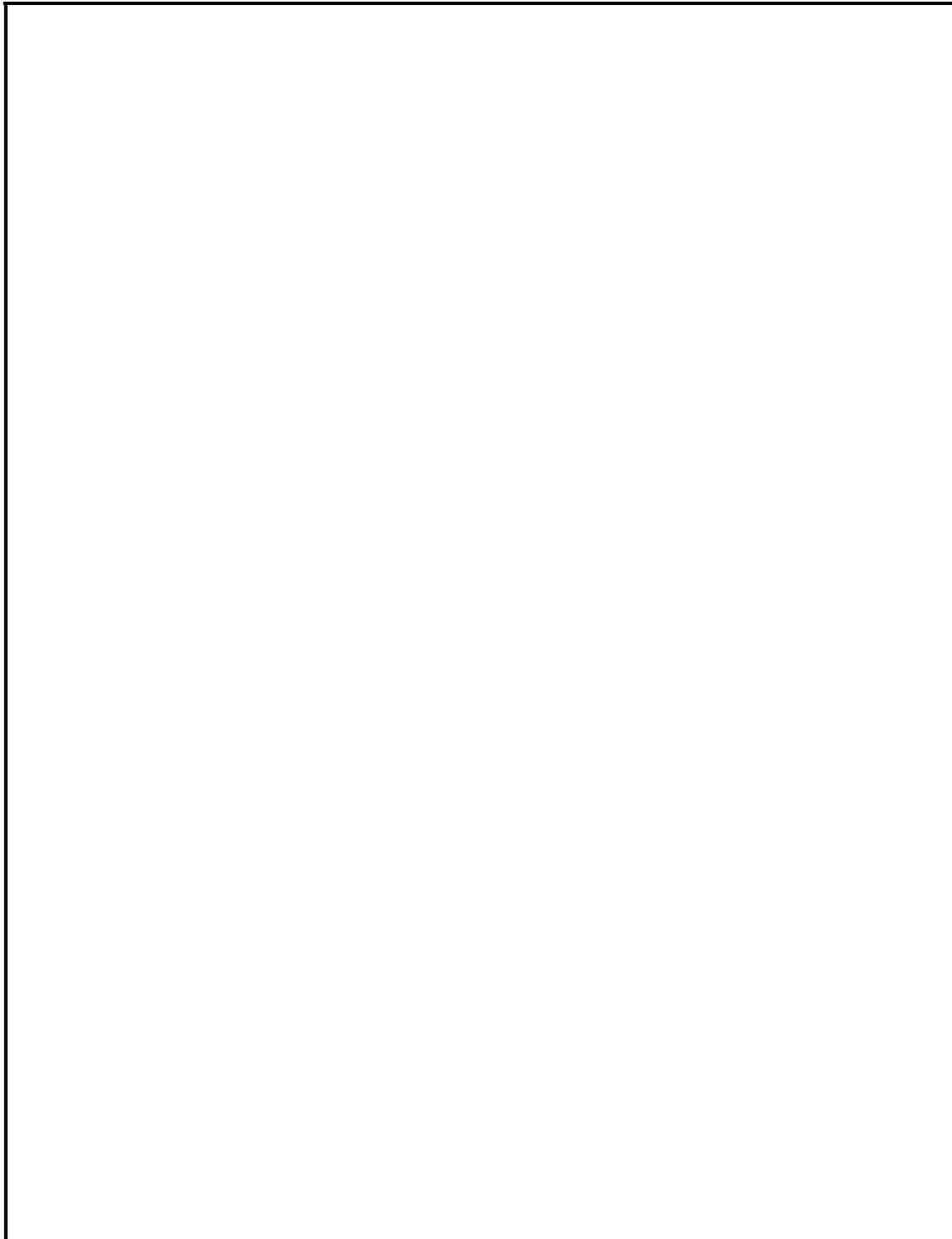


from Louisiana and Tennessee,

- incorporating data from sub-jurisdictions using different systems: panelist from California, and
- using a data warehouse to generate and manage notifications: panelist from Minnesota.
