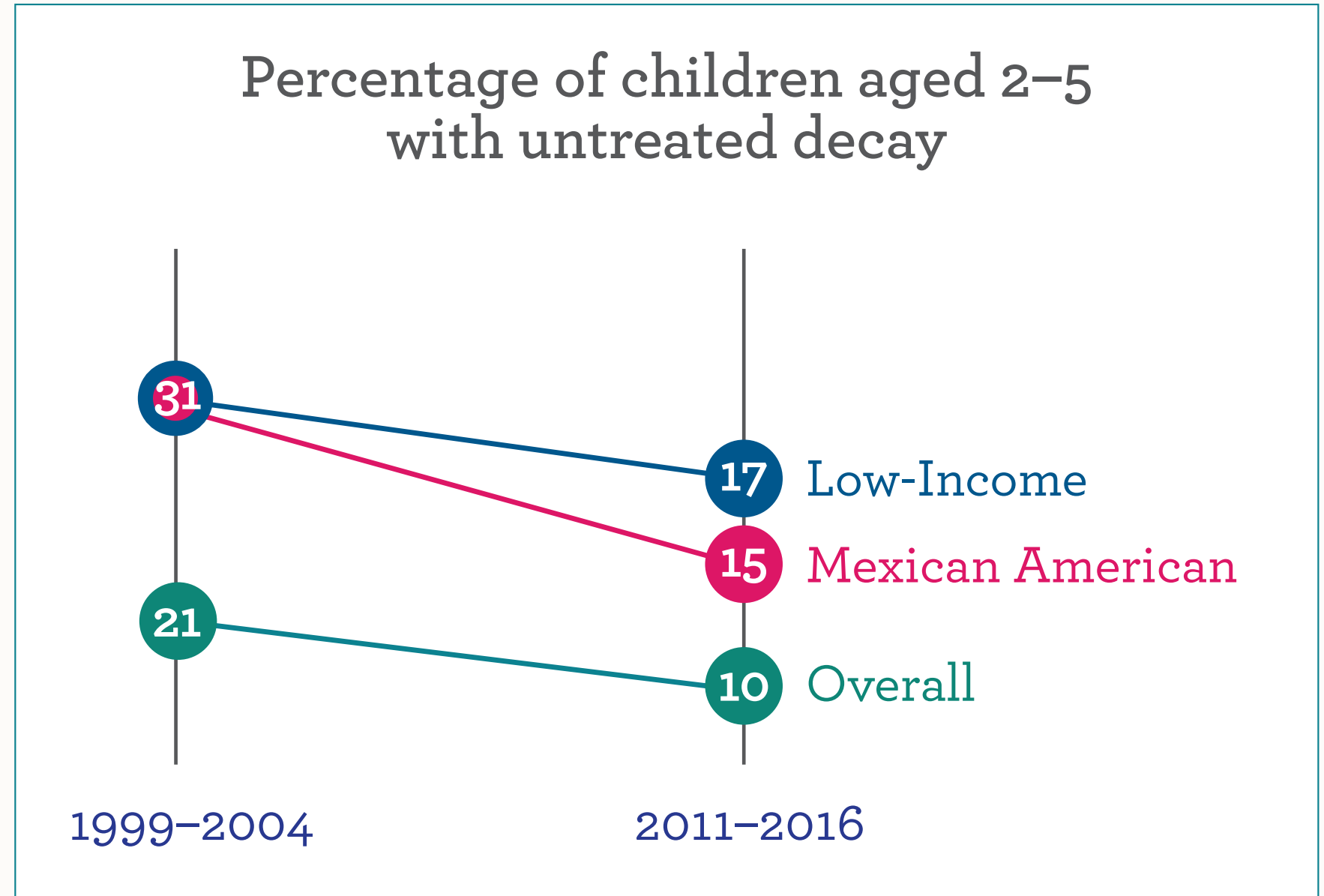


Untreated tooth decay declined in young children



Since 1999–2004, the prevalence of **untreated tooth decay** in primary teeth of children aged 2–5 years **has dropped by half.**



Mexican American and **low-income** children saw the **greatest declines.**
