The health care system could save up to

**Medical-dental Integration** between **oral health** and **chronic disease prevention programs** benefits patients and saves money.

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School sealant programs could

Programs that deliver sealants to children at high risk for tooth decay save money. Each tooth sealed saves **more than \$11** in dental treatment costs.

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Providing **optimally fluoridated water** to U.S. communities for one year saves

# \$6.5B

in dental treatment costs and offers an average **return on investment** of **\$20** for every **\$1** spent

On average, communities with water fluoridation experience **25% fewer** cavities, saving **\$32 per person annually** by avoiding dental treatment costs and leading to fewer missed work and school days.
