Nearly half of adults aged 20–64 years who were:

- non-Hispanic black
- low-income
- had less than a high school education
- currently smoking cigarettes

had untreated tooth decay

non-Hispanic black

non-Hispanic white*

low-income

higher-income*

less than HS education more than HS education*

currently smoking cigarettes

never smoked cigarettes*

This is **2x the amount** of untreated decay as the comparison groups.
