New MMWR Highlights First Month of COVID-19 Vaccine Safety Monitoring

CDC released today, February 19, an MMWR on the <u>First month of COVID-19 vaccine safety monitoring — United States, December 14, 2020—January 13, 2021</u>. Data from the first month of COVID-19 vaccine safety monitoring provides reassurance about the safety of COVID-19 vaccines currently being used in the United States, as well as helpful information regarding what to expect following vaccination.

The report provides data from two vaccine safety monitoring systems: Vaccine Adverse Events Reporting System (VAERS) and v-safe. <u>V-safe</u> is a new smartphone-based, after-vaccination health checker for people who receive COVID-19 vaccines. <u>VAERS</u> is a passive reporting system, meaning it relies on individuals to send in reports of their experiences to CDC and the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

The initial post-authorization safety profiles of the two COVID-19 vaccines in current use did not find evidence of unexpected reporting patterns or safety concerns. During this time, more than 13.5 million doses were administered. Since the vaccines were authorized in December 2020, safety monitoring for these vaccines has been the most intense and comprehensive in U.S. history.

CDC encourages jurisdictions to continue promoting the <u>v-safe after vaccination health checker</u> and to ask their vaccination providers to distribute the <u>v-safe information sheet</u> to vaccine recipients and to encourage vaccine recipients to <u>register for v-safe</u>.

GSA Provides COVID-19 Response Support Resources

The General Services Administration (GSA) has completed a COVID-19 response support package that will enable state, tribal, local, and territorial health departments to enter into contracts with vendors who can support surge staffing and other needs in their jurisdictions. Working with CDC over the last several months, GSA has developed a "Best Practices Ordering Guide" and templates to support the acquisition process, including cost estimate worksheets and requests for quotes. GSA has a designated team of support staff who are available to help walk through the acquisition process with health department staff. More than 120 vendors responded to GSA's market research which covers all regions of the country, territories, and freely associated states. Jurisdictions can also receive copies of the documents, or request assistance, by emailing CRSSHelp@gsa.gov. The scope of services include medical and other personnel, equipment, wrap-around services, contact tracing, and logistical support. GSA's Acquisition Gateway includes a section on its front page for COVID-19 resources.

New CDC Operational Strategy for K-12 Schools Now Available Online

CDC released a new Operational Strategy for K-12 Schools to incorporate the best available evidence at this time. The indicators and thresholds in the operational strategy replace the core indicators in the Indicators for Dynamic School Decision-Making. Updates to CDC Vaccine Communication Product Inventory Now Available

The CDC COVID-19 Vaccine Task Force maintains a Communication and Education Product Inventory on the Immunization Services Division Awardee SharePoint portal in the "COVID-19 > Communication Content" folder. This resource also includes a summary of the status of related reporting on contact tracing and discussion of the impact of increasing levels of community spread on states' abilities to collect and report outbreak data. The <u>Phased Allocation Of COVID-19 Vaccines</u>: <u>State and Territorial Approaches</u> table provides information on state and territorial plans for phased allocation of COVID-19 vaccines.
