COMBINATION OF TEMPERATURES BETWEEN 80 AND 86 DEGREES, AND  
RELATIVE HUMIDITIES IN THE MID TO UPPER 80S WILL ONCE AGAIN  
RESULT IN LOCALIZED HEAT INDICES UP TO 99 DEGREES DURING  
THE LATE AFTERNOON.

BESIDES THE HEAT...NO OTHER HAZARDOUS WEATHER IS EXPECTED  
AT THIS TIME.

WET MICROBURST POTENTIAL:
