¹ Breast and Cervical Cancer, Diabetes, Domestic HIV/AIDS Prevention, and STD/TB Prevention are no longer tracked as individual PARTs. Breast and Cervical Cancer and Diabetes PARTs were subsumed into the Chronic Disease Prevention and Health Promotion PART in 2006. Domestic HIV/AIDS Prevention and STD/TB Prevention were subsumed into the National Center for HIV/AIDS, Viral Hepatitis, STD and TB Prevention PART in 2007.

² Health Alert Network, Epidemic Services and Response, and Infectious Diseases are no longer being tracked for the purposes of PART. Health Alerting is no longer a separate function within CDC. Instead, it is an element of State and Local Readiness within the Terrorism program. Under CDC's new CDC budget structure, the Epidemic Services and Response budget activity no longer exists. Accordingly, the activities that took place under this former budget activity are now dispersed across the Agency within Health Information and Services, Global Health and Public Health Improvement and Leadership. Similarly, Infectious Diseases was part of the Coordinating center for Infectious Diseases reorganization of 2006 and no longer exists as a National Center. Portions of Infectious Diseases activities were distributed to the National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases, the National Center for HIV/AIDS, Viral Hepatitis, STD and TB Prevention, the National Center for Zoonotic and Vector-Borne Diseases, and the National Center for Preparedness, Detection and Control of Infectious Diseases.


