

# Terrestrial Rabies Reservoirs in the United States, 2010




## Rabies in Wild Animals, 1961-2011








# Rabid Skunks Reported in the United States during 2011






# Rabid Foxes Reported in the United States during 2011









# Rabid Cats and Dogs Reported in the United States during 2011
