

Region I

In 2009, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region I was 5.1%, representing a slight decrease since 2008 (5.2% positivity). Region I has been using nucleic acid amplification tests for all chlamydia testing (100%) in this population since 2004.



