



In 2009, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region IX was 8.3%, representing a slight increase since 2008 (7.5% positivity). In 2009, 99.1% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.
