


Region X

In 2010, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region X was 6.6%, representing an increase since 2009 (6.0%). In 2010, 99.9% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.
