

Guam, 2010

Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Guam reported 1 case in 2010.
- RATES: Guam ranked 46 among 52 areas (49 states; Washington, DC; and 2 territories) reporting at least one case of P&S syphilis with 0.6 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 4.5 cases per 100,000 population.


Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Guam, the rate among males was 0.0 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 7.9 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 1.1 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 1.1 per 100,000.

Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Guam reported 0 cases in 2010.
- RATES: Guam had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.7 cases per 100,000.
