

# Puerto Rico, 2010

## Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Puerto Rico reported 228 cases in 2010.
- RATES: Puerto Rico ranked 9 among 52 areas (49 states; Washington, DC; and 2 territories) reporting at least one case of P&S syphilis with 5.7 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 4.5 cases per 100,000 population.


## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Puerto Rico, the rate among males was 11.0 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 7.9 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.9 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 1.1 per 100,000.


## Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Puerto Rico reported 2 cases in 2010.
- RATES: Puerto Rico ranked 20 among among 30 areas (28 states; Washington, DC; and 1 territory) reporting at least one case of congenital syphilis with a rate of 4.3 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.7 cases per 100,000.
