

# Guam, 2011

## Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Guam reported 5 cases in 2011.
- RATES: Guam ranked 28 among 51 areas (48 states; Washington, DC; and 2 territories) reporting at least one case of P&S syphilis with 2.8 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 4.5 cases per 100,000 population.

## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex


- In Guam, the rate among males was 3.3 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 8.2 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 2.2 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 1.0 per 100,000.

## Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Guam reported 0 cases in 2011.
- RATES: Guam had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.5 cases per 100,000.
