

Puerto Rico, 2012

Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Puerto Rico reported 306 cases in 2012.
- RATES: Puerto Rico reported 8.3 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 5.0.


Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Puerto Rico, the rate among males was 16.1 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 9.3.
- The rate among females was 1.0 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9.


Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Puerto Rico reported 1 case in 2012.
- RATES: Puerto Rico had a rate of 2.2 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 7.8.
