



# Region I

In 2008, the chlamydia positivity rate in 15- to 24-year-old women tested in family planning clinics in Region I was 5.2%, representing a slight increase since 2007 (4.8% positivity). Region I has been using nucleic acid amplification tests for all chlamydia testing (100%) in this population since 2004.
