


Region III

In 2008, the chlamydia positivity rate in 15- to 24-year-old women tested in family planning clinics in Region III was 6.3%, representing a slight increase since 2007 (5.5% positivity). In 2008, 77.9% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.
