


## Region V

In 2008, the chlamydia positivity rate in 15- to 24-year-old women tested in family planning clinics in Region V was 7.6%, representing no change since 2007. Region V has been using nucleic acid amplification tests for all chlamydia testing (100%) in this population since 2007.
