



## Region VI

In 2008, the chlamydia positivity rate in 15- to 24-year-old women tested in family planning clinics in Region VI was 10.2%, representing an increase since 2007 (8.8% positivity). In 2008, 91.5% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.
