


Region IX

In 2008, the chlamydia positivity rate in 15- to 24-year-old women tested in family planning clinics in Region IX was 7.5%, representing a slight increase since 2007 (7.3% positivity). In 2008, 85.4% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.
