


Region III

In 2009, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region III was 6.4%, representing a slight increase since 2008 (6.3% positivity). In 2009, 99.3% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.
