

## Region VI

In 2009, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region VI was 11.0%, representing a slight increase since 2008 (10.2% positivity). In 2009, 97.0% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.



