


Region II

In 2010, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region II was 7.0%, representing an increase since 2009 (6.5% positivity). In 2010, 92.9% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.
