In 2010, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region VI was 11.3%, representing an increase since 2009 (10.6% positivity). In 2010, 97.8% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.



