



## Region I


In 2011, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region I was 6.4%, representing an increase since 2010 (5.8% positivity). Region I has been using nucleic acid amplification tests for all chlamydia testing (100%) in this population since 2004.
