In 2011, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region X was 7.1%, representing an increase since 2010 (6.6%). In 2011, 99.6% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.





