

Region II

In 2011, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region II was 7.9%, representing an increase since 2010 (7.0% positivity). In 2011, 97.1% of all chlamydia tests reported in this population were nucleic acid amplification tests.




