

Region V

In 2011, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region V was 9.6%, representing an increase since 2010 (8.9% positivity). Region V has been using nucleic acid amplification tests for all chlamydia testing (100%) in this population since 2007.





