

Region VII

In 2011, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region VII was 7.9%, representing a slight increase since 2010 (7.7% positivity). Region VII has been using nucleic acid amplification tests for all chlamydia testing (100%) in this population since 2004.




