



## Region VIII


In 2011, the chlamydia positivity rate among women aged 15-24 years tested in family planning clinics in Region VIII was 8.4%, representing no change since 2010 (8.3%). Region VIII has been using nucleic acid amplification tests for all chlamydia testing (100%) in this population since 2005.
