

# Colorado, 2008

## Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Colorado reported 128 cases in 2008.
- RATES: Colorado ranked 24 among 50 states; Washington, DC; and 3 territories with 2.6 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 4.5 cases per 100,000 population.

## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Colorado, the rate among males was 5.1 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 7.6 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.1 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 1.5 per 100,000.


## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by race/ethnicity

- In Colorado, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 2.4 among whites, 6.3 among blacks, 3.1 among Hispanics, 0.7 among Asian/Pacific Islanders, and 2.5 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.
- The rate among blacks was 2.6 times that of whites.
- The rate among Hispanics was 1.3 times that of whites.


## Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Colorado reported 0 cases in 2008.
- RATES: Colorado had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 10.1 cases per 100,000.
