Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Guam reported 6 cases in 2008.
- RATES: Guam ranked 17 among 50 states; Washington, DC; and 3 territories with 3.5 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 4.5 cases per 100,000 population.


Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Guam, the rate among males was 5.7 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 7.6 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 1.2 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 1.5 per 100,000.

Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Guam reported 0 cases in 2008.
- RATES: Guam had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 10.1 cases per 100,000.
