

# Oregon, 2008

## Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Oregon reported 26 cases in 2008.
- RATES: Oregon ranked 45 among 50 states; Washington, DC; and 3 territories with 0.7 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 4.5 cases per 100,000 population.

## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Oregon, the rate among males was 1.3 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 7.6 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.1 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 1.5 per 100,000.


## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by race/ethnicity

- In Oregon, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 0.7 among whites, 0.0 among blacks, 1.3 among Hispanics, 0.0 among Asian/Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.
- The rate among Hispanics was 1.9 times that of whites.


## Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Oregon reported 0 cases in 2008.
- RATES: Oregon had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 10.1 cases per 100,000.
